The Dining Out is coming soon!!!

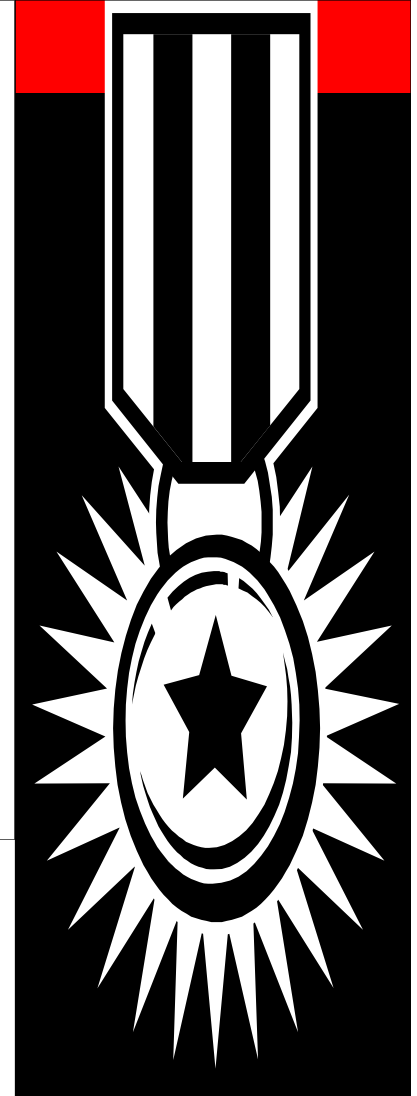
March 3, 2010.

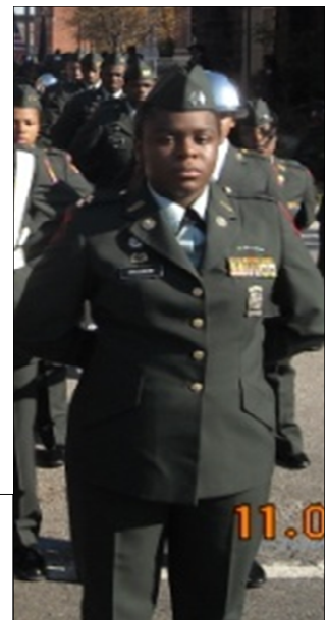
